

## Washington State 4-H Hall of Fame Nomination Form – Due June 1

The Washington State 4-H Hall of Fame was established to recognize individuals and organizations that have had a significant impact upon the 4-H Youth Development Program and/or its members and leaders at any time since 4-H's beginning. Recipients will be honored in October, at the State 4-H Forum.

**Eligibility:** Anyone who has made a significant contribution to the development of 4-H or 4-H'ers in Washington State. Current 4-H faculty and staff are not eligible. Nominees may be living or deceased. Nominations will be accepted from any person or group in the 4-H family.

A brief, <u>detailed\_nomination statement</u> attached on a separate piece of paper (using the following points as a guideline and not to exceed 2 pages in length), <u>and a photograph</u> of the nominee are required.

## **Nomination Information should include:**

- Role played (4-H member, club leader, project leader, fair superintendent, Extension faculty/staff, advisory boards, Foundation trustee, other volunteer, etc.).
- <u>Nominee's significant contribution to 4-H. *Be specific* (Leadership roles within project/club activity, offices &/or committee held state/local/county, general/community events or after school program nominee helped organize and run, etc.).</u>
- <u>Breadth or depth of their contribution</u> (Number of different projects/activities nominee was involved in for 4-H, years held office, how many committees involved in, attendance of state/national/county leadership activities, chaperone/provide transportation for youth).
- <u>Length of commitment</u> (Number of years of 4-H involvement; supporting 4-H; leaders council involvement; as staff 4-H; on state or national boards, camps or conference; etc.).
- <u>Impact on 4-H, either upon individuals or the entire program (Lasting impact on 4-H; change in policy as a result; impact on nominator, 4-H'ers, county, state or national; lifelong result of impact; adversities overcome, enhancement of personal growth, etc.).</u>

## Other factors as appropriate:

- Impact on the community.
- Major career accomplishments.
- <u>In what ways has the nominee been recognized (Awards within 4-H, Civic awards, other awards such as Grange, fair, legion, church, etc.)?</u>
- Financial contribution to 4-H (Amount of contribution, number of years contributing, variety of contribution).

\*We request that photographs accompany the nomination form, but cannot be accepted later than September 15 if nominee is selected. <u>Only photos on photo paper or in digital format and no less than 600 dpi will be accepted</u>. If no photo is received, an appropriate 4-H image will be used in the banquet program and digital presentation.
