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Animal Educational Exhibits Due: Due June 29 or June 30th between 3:30 to 6:30 pm at the Floral Building at the Cowlitz County Fair Grounds.

Judging will occur and all exhibits will be available to pick up by 6:30 pm on June 30th
Except for those exhibits turned in at the last minute---they may not be judged by 6:30 pm and arrangements will need to be made to pick them up at a later time.

The 4H program or the Expo Center/Fairgrounds staff will not be responsible for those not picked up by 6:30 pm. So please plan ahead.

4H leaders or a designee can pick up posters by club.

Still Life Educational Exhibits Due: Sunday, July 23rd from 1 pm to 6 pm in the 4H Building

General rules for Educational Exhibits. Please Read!

1. Educational exhibits may show any topic of an educational nature as part of a 4-H project. In order to be judged, it cannot be a collection or display.
2. It must teach something to the public and be readable from 10 feet (see 4-H publication EM4573 for more information).
3. The display may include sound, motion, etc. **BUT NO GLITTER**
4. No copyrighted illustration or cartoons may be used in educational displays or posters.
5. Please use a separate entry form for educational exhibits. **Put your name, club, county name, current year, and grade in permanent ink on the back of the poster.** Failure to do so may disqualify the exhibit. Be sure to specify the correct lot on the entry form.
6. Any educational exhibit that is not a current year exhibit will be disqualified at the discretion of the superintendent and/or judge.
7. Exhibits entered on **Sunday, July 23rd** will remain in the 4-H Building and cannot be removed to the barns.
8. For very large displays, contact the Educational Exhibits Superintendent.

ONE BLUE RIBBON EDUCATIONAL EXHIBIT per exhibitor may be entered for the 4-H State Fair.

ANIMAL EDUCATIONAL EXHIBITS

1. Animal educational exhibits/posters for those wanting their posters displayed in the respective barns are due by above published date and time at the same time and place as the animal entry forms.
2. Each educational exhibit must have a completed 4H Youth Entry Form attached to the exhibit. **Put your name, club, county name, grade, and year in permanent ink on the back of the poster.** Failure to do so may disqualify the exhibit. Be sure to specify the correct lot on the entry form.
3. Exhibits will be judged within two days of entry. Please be sure to note the day and time of pick-up when you enter your posters.
4. **Posters must be picked up by club**, not by individual members and will be signed out by club. They can be picked up by the main club leader, assistant leader, designated 4-H member or designated parent
5. Animal educational posters not turned in by the above deadline may be turned in at the 4-H Building during still life entry day. However, they will be displayed in the 4-H Still Life Building during fair and not in the barns.
