CONSTITUTION GRANT-ADAMS AREA 4-H LEADER'S COUNCIL

I - Name

The name of this organization shall be Grant-Adams Area 4-H Leader's Council

II - Purpose

This group is organized for the purpose of advancing the best interests of 4-H work in the counties and state through the cooperation of area leader groups and WSU Extension.

III - Membership

All leaders shall be eligible for active membership in this Council without regard to race, color, religion, sec or national origin. All adult and teen leaders are voting members.

IV- County Council Officers

- A. Grant-Adams Area 4-H Leader's Council officers shall be president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer, district representative.
- B. Election of officers shall be at the October meeting.
- C. Election shall be by ballot and a majority vote shall elect.
- D. Duties of the officers shall be as outlines in Roberts Rules of Order.
- E. Meetings are October, December, February, April, June, and August.
- F. Terms of office are for two consecutive years. Not to exceed two consecutive terms.

V - Areas

The Grant-Adams Area as defined by WSU Extension shall be divided into 8 areas. They shall meet in their respective areas every other month. In September the areas shall select a chairman, secretary, treasurer and such officers as they need to carry out their program. These officers are elected to one year terms, not to exceed two consecutive years.

VI - Fiscal Year

The fiscal year shall be from October 1 through September 30.

VII - Committees

All committees appointed by the president.

VIII - Amendments

Amendments to the constitution may be made by two-thirds majority of those attending a regular meeting of the Council. Major program policy changes will require a minimum of two readings at the regularly scheduled meeting before policy change may be accepted.
