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## **Scholarship Criteria**

- 1. The scholarship amount will be \$1,500 to be awarded annually to six applicants chosen from the Grant-Adams WSU Extension program area. Additionally, two alumni scholarships will also be awarded (\$1,500 each).
- 2. The scholarship will be announced by mid-late May.
- 3. The recipient of the scholarship must enroll in an accredited institution in an academic or vocational program within one year from the date the scholarship is awarded. He/she must have been enrolled in 4-H or FFA for at least two (2) years.
- 4. If the above criteria are not met, funds will be withheld..

## **Selection of Candidates**

- 1. All candidates for this scholarship shall submit their application to the high school counselor or extension office who in turn will forward applications to the committee. **The deadline for applications is April 1.**
- 2. The criteria for selection shall include, but not be limited to the following:
  - a. The student shall be a senior or equivalent homeschooler and have been in 4-H or FFA for at least two years, or be an alumnus of either organization.
  - b. The student must show leadership qualities, such as volunteer work, or membership in organizations, at school, church, or in the community.
  - c. The student must have a grade point average of at least 2.5 or higher and must maintain a GPA of 2.5 at college/vocational school.
  - d. Homeschoolers are also eligible. College pre-test scores will be used.
