Demonstration Gardens

Demonstration Gardens are created and maintained by Master Gardener Volunteers to teach plant selection and maintenance and sustainable garden practices. Educational brochures, signs and labels and fact sheets are made available to the public.

Moses Lake WSU Demonstration Garden, located in Civic Park next to the Moses Lake Library a t418 E 5th Avenue. Established in 2006, the garden is a developed native plant section and a drought tolerant plant section. It is readily accessible and elicits comments and questions from people passing by whenever Master Gardeners are present at the garden.

In Soap Lake, Healing Waters WSU Demonstration Garden is within the East Beach Soap Lake City Park approximately at the corner of First Avenue NE and Canna Street North. This garden is designed with four season water wise landscape plantings, requiring minimal care and maintenance. It is highly visible with WSU signs and plant labels.

The Othello Old Hotel WSU Demonstration Garden is adjacent to the Old Hotel Art Gallery, 33 E Larch St, Othello and an Othello Community Schools building. It was begun with a grant from the WSU King County Master Gardener Foundation. It features native and drought tolerant plants.
