Deadline: Scholarship applications need to be postmarked no later than **March 31, 2024**.

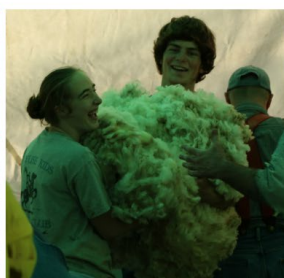
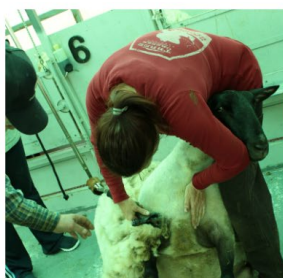
