

Before you register for Super Saturday...

Here are a few things to keep in mind before sending in your registration for Super Saturday which will be held at Enumclaw Middle School on February 4, 2017...

For those new to 4-H this event is a day of fun workshops where you can try your hand at a new craft, do some cooking, learn about 4-H activities at the fair, etc. Be sure to read through the entire listing of workshops and pick what things you want to learn about.

- 1) **There are classes for all ages, but please be sure to read the Recommended Age Levels and plan accordingly.** There are many classes offered for our youngest members (Cloverbuds & Juniors) but the instructors might be requesting a parent/adult to accompany their child for that particular workshop. If a parent/adult guardian is required to attend the workshop with a younger student—you will be assisting the student not taking an open spot.
- 2) **Youth 10 and under MUST have a parent/guardian on site with them at the event!**
Please do not drop off your child for the event if they are 10 and under.
- 3) **Pay attention to the class limit!** Some instructors are bringing supplies for their classes so there may be a limit to how many people can attend the workshop. These classes will be filled on a first come/first served basis—**registering early will help insure your spot in that workshop.** Be sure to indicate on your registration form a second choice for each session in case your first choice is not available. Registrations must be postmarked by Jan. 21st.
- 4) **All registration fees MUST accompany your paperwork when you send it in.** Please do not just send in the paperwork and expect to pay the Pre-registered fees the day of the event. If no fees accompany the paperwork, you will pay the Walk-in fee which will cost more. **An email confirmation will be sent to you when we receive your registration.**
- 5) **All youth attendees are required to send in a medical form with your registration.** We CANNOT use the forms from your clubs. We must have a separate form for each youth attendee. Medical forms for adults are recommended in case an emergency should arise.
- 6) **On-Line registration is NOT AVAILABLE!** Please send your forms and payment to the address on the registration form.
- 7) **Please plan to arrive and check-in on Super Saturday before the sessions start!** If you arrive late, you will not be able to attend the first session. We are requesting this out of respect for our instructors. If you think it will be difficult to arrive before 9 am, please do not register for the first session.
- 8) **Lunch options are for sale if you pre-register!** There will not be additional lunches available the day of the event. Feel free to bring your own lunch if you want.
- 9) **Invite your friends!** At this event, non 4-H youth are welcome to join in the fun. Registration requirements are the same, but they can certainly come and learn something new with their 4-H friends.
