2018 Workshop Locations

Addresses and directions to WSU Lewis County Workshops:

Fort Borst Park Demo Garden - Take I-5 to Exit 82 "Harrison Street" and turn west at light. Follow Harrison to Johnson Road (approx. ½ mile). Turn left on Johnson Road and go .2 miles to "T" intersection. Turn right and follow the road as it skirts past the NW Sport's Hub and the ball fields veer right until you get to the Parks maintenance shed. The garden is to your left between the One-Room schoolhouse and the historic Fort Borst Home.

Fort Borst Park Kitchen #1 & Kitchen #2 - Take Exit 82 "Harrison Street" heading west. Take first left onto Belmont Street, past gas station into the park. Kitchen #2 is on the right, Kitchen #1 is on the left.

Centralia College (Washington Hall) - 701 W. Walnut, Centralia, WA 98531.

Chehalis Timberland Library (Community Room) - 400 North Market Boulevard, Chehalis, WA 98532

Lewis County Transfer Station Centralia - 1411 South Tower, Centralia, WA 98531.

Providence Place Demo Garden - From I-5 take Exit 77 (Raymond-Pe Ell). Turn east onto Main Street and go .7 mile to South Market Blvd. ("T" intersection by Les Schwab Tires). Turn right and go .2 mile to SE 3rd Street. Turn left and go one block to SE Washington Ave. You'll need to find parking on the street around the building. Providence Place is a light brown apartment building that takes up the whole block.

Salkum Library Demo Garden and Salkum Timberland Library- From I-5, take Exit 68 (Morton/Yakima U.S. Hwy 12 East). The library is at 2480 U.S. Hwy 12, 12.5 miles from the freeway exit, Salkum, WA 98582.

WSU Lewis County Extension Meeting Room - located in the basement of the Historic Lewis County Courthouse, 351 NW North Street, Chehalis WA 98532. Enter on the west end of the building.
