OBSERVATIONS

4/29 (* = outstanding this date)

Bob White* - very attractive pink-and-white tree with some medium pink buds still to open, profuse bloom, spreading habit

Candymint Sargent - no buds open, dark magenta, invisible against purple-bronze leaves. Leaf color and low spreading habit add ornamental value

Evereste - medium pink buds, white flowers just opening

Jack* - full white bloom and fresh-looking, bright green leaves on very large impressive trees. Not for backyards! A fine park or highway landscape tree.

Lancelot* - compact dwarf form very attractive, symmetrical; green leaves overshadow the white bloom somewhat. Well suited to sidewalk or courtyard plantings

Louisa* - top rate for esthetics now- full of bright pink buds and pale pink flowers in weeping cascades, very profuse, light green leaves a nice contrast

M. Tschonoskii - no bloom 4/29 but upright columnar form with silvery-green new leaves is attractive *M. zumi x 'calocarpa'* - medium pink buds, white flowers just opening

Mary Potter - bright pink buds profuse, not open but adding color to entire tree, spreading small tree, attractive form

Maypole - upright columnar habit; early leaves copper-pink, buds large, long, magenta pink, conspicuous, opening to large magenta pink, single flowers

Pink Cloud - buds very large, rounded, magenta pink, on long stems, opening to light pink fully double flowers, profuse, very attractive, like miniature roses. New leaves bronze-red, older leaves olive green, note a couple of mildew strikes on tips.

Prairie Maid - no buds open, leaves bronze-green, less ornamental than Candymint or Prairifire **Prairifire** - no buds open, purplish red color of new leaves ornamental

Professor Sprenger - looks nice with light pink buds, white bloom starting to open

Purple Prince - profuse buds, magenta pink, give very attractive color to whole tree; foliage bronze-red. This cv is looking better as the trees mature.

Red Jade - buds rather small, medium pink, not very abundant

Sentinel - very attractive bright red buds color the whole tree before flowers open

Silverdrift* - Full bloom, dense, white, mildly fragrant, nice yard size trees, attractive rounded form

Sinai Fire - buds pale ivory pink, flowers just opening white

Sugar Tyme - nice clean white bloom, just starting to open, light pink buds

Tea - young trees, light pink, small bell shaped flowers, attractive; spreading rather irregular form

Winter Gem - light pink buds, white flowers (one tree removed, disease)

WSU Alkmene x Prima - buds are pale pink, large, open to white flowers

American Spirit* - attractive upright habit, large maroon buds open to magenta flowers, dark bronze-green leaves. Ornamental now, will be more so when in full bloom

Bob White* - spreading, showy tree still full of white bloom, impressive

Candymint Sargent - magenta buds, few flowers yet, bronze-green leaves and low spreading habit the main ornamental elements at this time

Christmas Holly* - small rounded tree full of white flowers, contrast to many medium pink buds

Cinderella - very dwarf habit, tiny bright pink buds, bright green leaves, young trees

David - nice green-and-white tree, ornamental but not outstanding

Evereste* - full bloom, tree at peak ornamental, loaded with very profuse, bright white flowers

Golden Raindrops - no flowers yet, but very profuse bright pink buds like a pink haze throughout the tree, attractive

Guinevere - very dwarf habit, no bloom yet, magenta pink buds, bronze-green leaves, young trees **Indian Magic*** - ornamental pink color, bronze leaves blend with large maroon buds, magenta flowers just beginning to open

Jack - flowers large, white but most bloom has fallen

Jewelberry - small spreading trees, finely branched, small bright pink buds, white flowers

Lancelot - past full bloom, attractive form, green leaves in tufts at top of upright branches

Lollipop - very dwarf habit, tiny pale ivory-pink buds, bright green leaves, young trees

Louisa* - handsome weeping tree, cascades of light rose pink flowers, bright green leaves, highly ornamental *M. Tschonoskii* - buds white, flowers small, white, not abundant, inconspicuous in leafy silvery green tree *M. zumi x "calocarpa "** - full bloom, profuse white flowers fill tree, some medium pink buds give contrast **Maypole*** - excellent ornamental, full bloom with very large bright magenta flowers, purple-bronze new leaves, narrow columnar growth habit

Molten Lava* - big showy tree, semi-weeping habit, cascades of white flowers, medium pink buds **Morning Sun** - rather whippy, spreading branches, large attractive white flowers

"Pink Cloud"* - tree full of beautiful full double mauve-pink flowers, flowers look like mini-roses w. 12-17 petals, bronze-green leaves, upright spreading habit, attractive landscape or specimen, highly ornamental **Pink Princess** - no bloom yet, small maroon buds very profuse, spreading habit, early leaves bronze-purple **Prairie Maid** - no flowers yet, small maroon buds very profuse, add some color to tree, green leaves tinged bronze give tree olive-green cast

Prairifire - bright pink flowers just starting to open, ornamental now but not at its peak, bronze leaves are small, some branches look a little bare

Professor Sprenger* - full of white bloom, some medium pink buds give contrast

Purple Prince* - full bloom now, very attractive overall magenta pink, blends with bronze-purple new leaves

Red Jade - attractive weeping tree habit but rather sparse bloom, young trees

Red Jewel - flowers just starting to open, small pale ivory buds, very profuse, small white flowers, young **Sentinel** - bright pink buds give whole tree a rosy hue

Silverdrift - past full bloom but still full of white flowers, attractive at distance

Sinai Fire - green-and-white tree, moderately attractive, white bloom a bit sparse, mildew on shoot tips **Snowdrift** - very nice well shaped tree, attractive white flowers, just not outstanding

Sugar Tyme* - profuse bright white bloom, pale pink buds, showy trees

Tea - full bloom, small pale pink bell-shaped flowers, spreading tree habit, young trees

White Angel - flowers starting to open but only moderately attractive, old fruits retained, dark contrast Winter Gem - light pink buds, profuse white flowers, moderately attractive

WSU Alkmene x Prima* - large attractive flowers fill the tree, faint pinkish cast overall, green leaves Marilee (WSU-Jarmin) - narrow upright habit, very large bright pink buds, a few flowers opening, bronze-green leaves

5/15 (* = outstanding this date)

Adirondack* - nearly full bloom, some popcorn buds pale pink, brilliant white flowers, lower part of some limbs shy of bloom, narrow upright habit

American Spirit* - just past full bloom, very attractive, large bright magenta pink flowers, upright habit Candymint Sargent* - full bloom, attractive pink color overall, flowers bright pink with paler pink margins, color and low spreading form both very ornamental

Christmas Holly* - full bloom, mass of bright white flowers, very attractive small rounded tree shape **Cinderella** - very small dwarf tree, near full bloom, white medium size flowers, green leaves **David** - attractive green-and-white tree but nothing spectacular

Donald Wyman - green-and-white tree, fresh looking and moderately attractive

Guinevere - very small dwarf tree, horizontal spreading habit, medium pink buds open to pinkish white flowers, bronze-edged leaves

Golden Raindrops* - not full bloom yet but very attractive, large spreading trees full of pale pink buds and white flowers

Indian Magic* - full bloom, overall impression of magenta pink tree, flowers blend attractively with new reddish to bronze green leaf shoots

Jewelberry* - full bloom, attractive pink-and-white bloom, delicate branch structure on small trees, make a nice courtyard specimen

Lollipop - buds not yet open, very small, pale ivory; bright green leaves

M. zumi x "calocarpa "* - still attractive but less than last week

Mary Potter* - full white bloom, very showy, nice tree shape (low spreading, small), outstanding right now **Maypole** - bloom almost done, coppery green new leaves are attractive

Molten Lava - green-and-white tree, attractive semi-weeping structure

Ormiston Roy - attractive green-and-white tree but nothing spectacular

Pink Cloud* - past its best but still very nice, pale pink blooms contrast to dark bronze-green leaves

Pink Princess* - very profuse bloom, small rose pink flowers crowd the branches, horizontal spreading habit similar to Candymint

Prairifire* - not quite full bloom, some branch areas lack flowers BUT overall great color, intense magenta pink is outstanding

Prairie Maid* - full bloom, very profuse, tree in beautiful rose pink (paler than Prairifire); top performer now

Purple Prince - most petals gone but tree still has an ornamental smoky-pink overall color (acceptable but past best)

Red Jewel* - full bloom, dense bright white bloom, flowers rather small, young trees look promising **Sentinel** - tree still attractive, bloom tinged pink with last buds opening

Silver Moon - huge green trees with white flower clusters just starting to open, light pink buds; park and highway landscape use allows proper scale

Sugar Tyme* - full bloom, brilliant white flowers fill upright spreading tree, impressive

White Angel* - full, attractive white bloom, densely clustered on long unbranched limbs; excellent at landscape distance, in closer view the old, dark dried fruits show too much.

Marilee (**WSU-Jarmin**)* - almost full bloom, large deep pink buds, large semi-double flowers, pink-and-white tree, very showy, upright habit, one of best now

5/21 (* = outstanding this date)

Adirondack* - small trees, narrow upright habit, topped with dense white bloom clustered at branch ends American Spirit - nearly all flowers gone but new purple-red shoots, upright habit give ornamental value Candymint* - past full bloom and pink color a bit faded but still abundant color, attractive Christmas Holly - dense white bloom still fills tree but a bit yellowed and fading

Cinderella - past full bloom, tiny trees look a little yellowed and fading

Golden Raindrops* - full bloom, mass of brilliant white starry flowers fill the large spreading trees - the best now!

Guinevere - flowers a bit yellowed, still fairly attractive, small low spreading trees

Indian Magic - pink flowers on branch ends only, paler pink, nice contrast to bronze-green leaves

Lollipop* - tiny trees (patio pots or bonsai) very small ivory white buds opening to bright white flowers, profuse bloom, nice contrast with bright green leaves

Maypole - all flowers gone but columnar form, new purple-red shoots give ornamental value **Pink Princess*** - past full bloom, very dense small flowers, nice pale pink overall color, ornamental **Prairie Maid*** - full bloom, all branches loaded with light rose pink flowers, fragrant, spectacular

Prairifire* - past full bloom but intense magenta pink color still excellent

Silver Moon* - huge trees, lots of large, pure white fragrant flowers in clusters, very impressive park sized trees, excellent display now

Marilee (WSU-Jarmin)* - full bloom, dense flowers on upright tree, attractive but loses overall pink hue as buds open to white flowers; still very ornamental
