Observations (New, young trees):

Firebird – Very profuse white single flowers, rather small, light fragrance; specimen tree grafted as standard; dense bushy growth habit, green leaves.

Holiday Gold – Bright pink buds open to white single flowers, very profuse, light fragrance; vigorous spreading tree habit, green leaves.

May's Delight – Dark lavender-pink buds open to light pink single flowers, profuse, little fragrance; broad spreading habit, leaves dark green tinged with bronze.

Orange Crush – Wine red buds open to bright pinkish-red single flowers, very profuse, filling every branch,

mild fragrance; bushy semi-weeping tree habit, dark green leaves. Spectacular color, better than Prairifire, looks promising.

Prairie Rose – Very large round dark pink buds open to large, fully double light pink flowers, like roses on a tree, moderately profuse, little fragrance; tree habit vigorous, seems to be somewhat upright, bright green leaves, sometimes lobed like oak leaves.

Pumpkin Pie – Light pink buds open to white single flowers, profuse, light fragrance; moderately vigorous, compact tree habit, green leaves, frequently lobed.

Scarlet Brandywine – Very large round wine-red buds open to large, fully double deep pink flowers, very rose-like, moderately profuse, little fragrance; tree habit vigorous, upright spreading, dark green leaves tinged with bronze. Very showy, looks promising as upright specimen tree.

Spring Sensation – Pinkish-red buds open to pale pink single flowers, fading in a few days to white, mild fragrance; tree habit compact spreading, dark green leaves tinged with bronze.
