<p>AMERICAN ORIGINAL BEEFSTEAK</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Hybrid 65 Days</p>	<p>Gardeners everywhere will love the heirloom look and feel of this variety's large 12 to 14 oz. beefsteak fruits that benefit from breeding to hold their texture and flavor longer after picking. Packed with exactly the right amount of flavor for fresh eating in salads and sandwiches.</p>
<p>BETTER BOY</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Hybrid 75 Days VFNASt LB Disease resistant</p>	<p>A spectacular, midseason variety with plump, juicy, deep red tomatoes that often weigh more than one pound. And once they arrive they just keep on coming! Fruits are extremely flavorful, with flesh that's juicy, yet firm. A highly adaptable variety that thrives in nearly any climate.</p>
<p>BHN 589</p> 	<p>Semi-Determinate Hybrid 75 Days to Maturity F 1-2, ToMV, V1</p>	<p>BHN 589 is a new high-yielding determinate tomato that works well under a variety of conditions. The fruit are deep red, 7-9 oz in size and best of all have an outstanding flavor. The long shelf life and crack tolerance mean this is a great one for both home gardeners and farmers markets.</p>
<p>BIG BEEF</p> 	<p>1994 AAS Winner Indeterminate Hybrid 73 Days to Maturity VFFNTASt</p>	<p>A good choice to try in virtually any climate, readily overcoming adverse growing conditions and adapting easily to different environments. Old-fashioned rich flavor. Smooth fruits are globe-shaped, weighing 9 oz. to one pound.</p>
<p>BUSH BEEFSTEAK</p> 	<p>Determinate Open Pollinated 62 Days to Maturity Container</p>	<p>This is the perfect sandwich-sized fruit produced on a square-foot, garden-sized plant. Solid-fleshed fruits of a deep, rich red, average 8 ounces on vigorous, bushy plants.</p>
<p>CARMELLO</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Hybrid 75 days to Maturity F 1, L, N, TMV, ToMV 0-2, V. IR: RK.</p>	<p>Carmello produces heavy clusters of round fruit on strong, uniform plants. Especially impressive is its generous size fruit and well-developed flavor for such an early hybrid tomato.</p>

<p>CELEBRITY</p> 	<p>Semi-Determinate Hybrid 70 Days to Maturity Disease resistant</p>	<p>A great, all-round, dependable choice for your "basic" tomato needs -- sandwiches, slicing, snacks, and bruschetta. The large tomatoes are prized for their flavor. The Semi-Determinate plant grows to a certain height (3 to 4 feet) but continues to produce fruit all season until frost.</p>
<p>EARLY GIRL</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Hybrid 57 Days to Maturity VFF</p>	<p>It's hard to find tasty, full-sized fruits like this extra-early in the season! Meaty, ripe, red fruits, 4 to 6 oz., are slightly flattened and bright crimson throughout. Very appealing, with firm texture and blemish-resistant skin. Heavy yields on hardy vines.</p>
<p>FANTASTIC</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Hybrid 80 Days VFA</p>	<p>Tasty, globe-shaped, scarlet red, 3 to 5", medium-sized fruits are almost crack-free. Rich in beefsteak flavor. Heavy yields are excellent for canning.</p>
<p>GIANT F1</p> 	<p>Indeterminate Hybrid 65 Days to Maturity F1, 2 V, Xap</p>	<p>A large tomato that tastes delicious even when the summer is cool. This tomato serves up a dark red interior that is juicy and meaty with low acid. A compact vine set lots of jumbo early fruit that were quick to mature, and outweighed Big Beef.</p>
<p>JUBILEE</p> 	<p>AAS Winner Indeterminate Open Pollinated 75 Days to Maturity</p>	<p>Mild flavor and low acidity make this one of the best varieties for tomato juice. Bright, golden-orange fruits, 2-1/2 to 3" in diameter average 6 to 7 oz. apiece and have meaty, thick walls. Fruits are solid, with few seeds. Produce high yields, making them ideal for home garden or fresh market.</p>
<p>LEGEND</p> 	<p>Determinate Open Pollinated 68 Days to Maturity LB</p>	<p>Legend not only demonstrates tolerance of late blight, but is also one of the earliest maturing slicing tomatoes we know of. Legend produces amazingly sweet tomatoes with just the right amount of acid flavor. The big, 4-5 inch, parthenocarpic fruit are glossy red, with a uniform round shape.</p>

<p>MOSKVICH</p> 	<p>Semi-determinate 60 Days to Maturity Crack-resistant.</p>	<p>Smallish, 4-6 ounce fruits, very uniform, globular and deep red. Produced early and abundantly, the crack-resistant fruits are of outstandingly good flavor, used fresh or for canning and cooking. Performs well in cool to cold conditions, like so many of the Russian types.</p>
<p>OREGON SPRING</p> 	<p>Determinate Open Pollinated 60 Days to Maturity V</p>	<p>Early variety that sets loads of meaty fruits weighing 3 to 5 oz., with excellent flavor. Compact plants set fruits even in cool weather and continue to yield all season long. Nearly seedless. A perfect choice for ketchup and sauces.</p>
<p>SILETZ</p> 	<p>Determinate Parthenocarpic 60 days. F 1, V.</p>	<p>Siletz is one of the most reliable slicing tomatoes you can grow. Coming in just ahead of Oregon Spring with a nice flush of 4-5 inch deep red fruit that weigh up to 7-10 ounces. The flavor-packed red tomatoes are nearly seedless. Expect several bursts of ripe tomatoes as the season progresses.</p>
