

SAN JUAN COUNTY LEADERS COUNCIL MEETING - OCTOBER 23, 1982

The San Juan County Leaders Council met in the Extension Office on Saturday, October 23, 1982. Present were: Sue Hudson, Cathy Eaton, Ruth Ploghoft, Michele Sutton, Grace Swan, Diana Clark, Dan Paulson, Patti Black, Jeanne Flynn, Carol Ogden, Burrell Osburn, Lee Campbell and Marie Boe.

A discussion on the Pierre Franklin Scholarship Award resulted in a motion to present the award to a graduating senior at the High School graduation exercises. Applications will be due in the Extension Office by May 1. An alternate will also be chosen. Scholarship money will not be given until the college requirements are completed. Motion passed.

Cathy Eaton, Burrell Osburn and Patti Black make up the committee to revamp the requirements for Perpetual Trophies for: Sheep sponsored by the Franklin family; Beef sponsored by Ted B. Richey and Swine sponsored by Doug Franklin. It was suggested the sponsors of the awards should also be considered. Committee report is due before January 1, 1983.

Doug and Joyce Franklin are working on plans for bathroom facilities near the camping area for 4-H campers during the Fair.

Cathy Eaton wants a Livestock Arena between the Sheep and Goat barns. The Fair Board has asked for plans to be presented to them for observation. Cathy will ask for prices from Texas. Hopefully, the Fair Board will be able to meet 50% of costs. The Fair Board will lose some parking area when the arena is built.

Puyallup Report: Sue Hudson asked that leaders notify the Extension Office as soon as possible of 4-H members who would be eligible and interested in going to the Puyallup Fair. It would also be helpful in coordinating rides to know the adults who would be available and willing to go.

Cathy Eaton suggested the Leaders Council should provide a "San Juan County Banner" for livestock members to exhibit with their animals at the Puyallup Fair. It was decided that Leaders Council purchase materials for making three banners. Michele Sutton from Orcas volunteered to make one; Jeannie Flynn from Lopez and Cathy Eaton and Patti Black of Friday Harbor will be responsible for making the other two.

The Leaders Council will present a "Friends of 4-H Plaque" to Mr. and Mrs. Phil Miller at the San Juan Achievement Night program as a thank you for providing Hot Air Balloon rides during the Fair to 4-H members who had won rosettes in 4-H participation activities.

A Treasurer's report was given as: \$796.23 in County Council Fund \$1,971.74 in the Pierre Franklin Scholarship Fund and \$100.00 in the OPALCO Transportation Fund.

It was also mentioned that Community Service should be recorded in the Record Books.
