

SAN JUAN COUNTY LEADERS COUNCIL MEETING - FEBRUARY 3, 1985

The San Juan County Leaders Council meeting was held Sunday, February 3, 1985 in the Extension office in Friday Harbor. Present were Jeanine Flynn of Lopez, Burrell Osburn, Greg and Patti Black, Ruth Ploghoft, Lee Campbell and Marie Boe of Friday Harbor.

President Ruth Ploghoft called the meeting to order at 11:13 A.M.

The minutes were read and approved after entering the request made by Lopez that San Juan Island Leaders Council be reimbursed the amount they loaned to the San Juan County Leaders Council for purchase of Completion Pins for the 1984 4-H Achievement Night programs.

OLD BUSINESS:

Our treasury earned \$80.00 from the turkey raffle during the County Fair and \$36.00 from Greg Black after he purchased the Saddle Pad.

The Council estimated our needs to be about \$800.00 or more for each year to include:

- \$300.00 for Award pins
- 300.00 for trips
- 200.00 for Leader education

We would like to have a countywide activity to support this program. Some suggestions were:

2. Chili Feed ~~March~~ April 4
3. Amateur Night. April 19
4. Turkey Raffle at the Fair

Patti was appointed Chairman of the Chili Feed for San Juan Island and will get the details and report back to Ruth. Burrell would handle publicity. Jeanine Flynn will check the same for Lopez.

Lee suggested we send a ballot with our suggestions to each leader and request a prompt reply in lieu of another county meeting because we are not getting a substantial turnout for our meetings.

NEW BUSINESS:

Patti asked if we could consider a 5-county Livestock Judging session in San Juan. Each person attending would bring a sack lunch and Friday Harbor would serve juice.

After the date for the chili feed is confirmed, a date for a District Livestock Judging Clinic will be set, probably May 11 or 18. Lee will contact Whatcom, Skagit, Island and Snohomish county agents for their date preferences.

FFA students will be welcomed as well as 4-H members.

Marie read a letter regarding financial help for the Ambassador program. Lee said we are not obligated because we do not have an Ambassador program. He was not able to get a San Juan Island leader because all the older San Juan kids are already too involved to participate.

Jeanie Flynn will check with Lopez. She felt there may be some interest on Lopez because they do not compete with the number of activities that we do.

Marie also read a letter from Amy Besola expressing her thanks and gratitude for the Pierre Franklin Memorial Scholarship. She had included a grade transcript with her letter. She is on the President's Honor Roll with a straight "A" grade average.

The next meeting is scheduled for Saturday, June 15, possibly at Orcas. Plans will be finalized after the next ferry schedule is issued.
