AGENDA DISCUSSION

4-H FAIR CLEANUP DAYS -- August 5 and 12.

DEMONSTRATION DAY -- Thursday, August 17, 1989.

Kate Carlisle, Chairman. Roberta Crosby, Larry Cochran and Kathy Rutledge will give names of persons from their respective islands who would be available to serve as judges for the contest.

STYLE REVUE -- Wednesday, August 9, 1989.

Time and place will be determined when the new ferry schedule is available.

LIVESTOCK STALL FEE -- A discussion was held on whether or not to initiate a stall fee for livestock entries. It was decided that each Livestock Leader will assume the responsibility for seeing that each 4-H Livestock Member leaves a clean pen after the Fair.

LIVESTOCK ENTRIES -- 4-H members must have livestock in their possession as follows:

- a- Market steers, breeding beef and Dairy -- 120 days prior to the Fair.
- b- Sheep, swine and horses -- 90 days prior to the Fair.

GRAND CHAMPION/ROUND ROBIN CONTESTS

Larry made a motion "that all animal owners who win a Grand Champion must declare at the time of winning if they will be available for the Round Robin Contest. If not, the Reserve Grand Champion will be given the honor to participate in the Round Robin. This regulation stops with the Reserve Champion".

Motion seconded and passed.

RECORD BOOKS -- Due in the County Agent's office July 31, 1989.

Record Books should be completed up to the day of entering for pre-fair judging. Any additional information or action after this date should be entered when the books are returned to them after the Fair.

Judges will also be informed.
