The San Juan County Leaders Council meeting was held Sunday, May 2, in the Courthouse Conference Room. The meeting was called to order at 11:15 A.M. by President Ruth Ploghoft. Present were: Tracy Betcher of Orcas, Kathy Hopkins of Shaw, Larry Cochran, Mary Jenison and Becky Lehman of Lopez, Margie Diffner, Marlys Foley, Milene Henley, Ruth Ploghoft, Gary Posenjak, Jan Smith, Diane Waldron, Marie Boe and County Agent Tom Schultz of Friday Harbor.

The minutes were read and approved.

Tom opened the meeting explaining the 4-H program and the active rolls of leaders, programs available and how they work. He welcomes suggestions of how we want the 4-H program and the activities to function. Tom also welcomes news items and articles for his 4-H newsletter.

Ruth appointed a committee of two, Larry Cochran and Mary Jenison, to represent 4-H at the Fair Board meetings.

It was agreed that a "Program of Events" and "4-H Rules in General" be located in several areas during the Fair---such as the barns, 4-H Building, Pop Stand and etc.

A motion was made and passed, "4-H members will not be allowed to compete and or share the same animal in 4-H classes".

4-H members are expected to report to the 4-H Building for assignments in keeping the building clean and attractive.

Educational posters in the 4-H Building and The Barns will be judged and on exhibit with ribbons.

Discussions were held on the following:

1. The possibility of 4-H members giving demonstrations at different locations during the fair as a crowd pleasing activity.
2. Daily high point horse awards will be awarded at the end of each day.
3. Overall horse awards to be scheduled for the last entry of the program on the last day of the Fair.
4. Entry tags sent to 4-H Club.

5. Style Revue is scheduled for Saturday, August 7, on Lopez Island.
6. Any 4-H changes for the Fair Book to be sent to the Extension Office ASAP.
