

## Rambler Booth Meeting

The Rambler Booth has been profitable for 2 years. Last year we paid fees (rent) \$250 and percentage of gross income (10% of profit) \$400 to the fair board. We will request an exemption from the fees. Ginny and Terry will create the letter to the fair board to make this request. We need to review the fair board minutes to confirm that 4H was and should continue to be exempt from the fees incurred by the fair board.

Warmer – We are in need of a warmer for the booth. Ginny will contact Kate Stone and Terry will contact Debbie Rishell.

Propane – Lisa will contact Vander Yacht propane to have the tank filled before the fair. Possible donation?

Menu – This year we will add Biscuits and Gravy to the breakfast menu. We will add a croissant grilled chicken sandwich to the lunch menu. We will also add Tabasco, salsa and ketchup to the condiments.

Schedule for 2006 fair – Open Tuesday, August 15, 7 am to 11 am, with a limited breakfast menu. Open Wednesday through Saturday, August 16 through 7 am to 4 pm with full breakfast and lunch menu. We will ask all 4H clubs to do as many shifts as possible. One shift will be 2 hours and 15 minutes. The fifteen minutes is needed for transition time.

Repairs and Maintenance – Due to water and weather damage rear entry door needs to be replaced and floor by rear entry door needs to be cut out and replaced. Need to replace fluorescent light fixtures with covered light fixtures. Need to bring thermometers for fridges and freezers up to code. See last year's inspection list for complete code update requirements.
